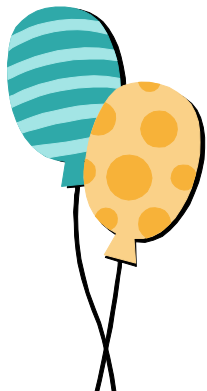

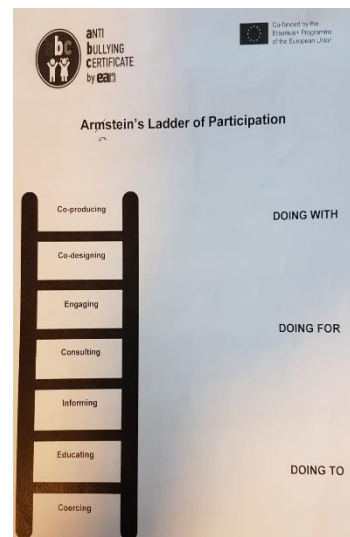

<i>answer</i>	<i>number</i>	<i>percentage</i>
Don't score at all	9	28%
Suggest a score but negotiate the final level with the school	4	13%
Give a score but allow the school not to publish it	8	25%
Ideally, all schools should be scored and show their level of safety publicly	11	34%

In a survey people were mixed about whether to score schools.

In this survey some Broadgreen school students took part, but not from other countries.

What do you think?

Opinion students on scoring schools:

Don't score on number of activities
 Not everyone has to agree fully
 Consider how many people are interested to assess the level
 Integrate diversity, not separate score
